Dimensions of the Position

The Web Developer has the role of collaboratively developing the use of the Internet and electronic technologies for the promotion of UNE Partnerships and the delivery of online services to students, partner organisations and clients.

Position Objectives

To develop and maintain the UNE Partnerships promotional website ensuring it is up-to-date, accurate, user friendly, structured for effective national and international exposure and searches, and is consistent with global standards.

To develop web-based resources in line with company strategies and agreed budgets for best practice in online learning.

To work collaboratively across the company, and in particular with Marketing and Systems, as an important and valued team member in Design & Development.

Website

To implement web-based features and formats which enhance the website as a commercial/educational/marketing resource

To propose creative design and technical solutions for online promotional activities, both proactively and as a result of feedback from staff and users

To fine-tune web applications, coding and style sheets for improved web design and maintenance

To adhere to presentation standards for public website

Education products and services

To coordinate and undertake the conversion of raw copy and images to web formats using a range of graphic, sound and web development software to agreed design and technical guidelines

To problem solve, implement solutions and achieve timely completion of projects, in liaison with the Design & Development team and external clients

To develop technical and operational procedures and guidelines as required

To proactively maintain relevant industry skills and knowledge - and develop new skills as necessary

Selection criteria
